Brief

Project	short video around 5 minutes in duration
Shoot	two days production with HDV Digital Cameras
Edit	two days postproduction facilities using Final Cut Pro

Equipment & Resources

Metro Screen will provide equipment and facilities hire, stock and postproduction facilities as specified to in the MMS contract. Each filmmaker will administer a production budget of \$2000 to cover production expenses including: crew, catering, art department etc.

The Multicultural Mentorship Scheme (MMS) project should be seen as an opportunity for a writer/director to gain experience and access to making a short video.

Please note, the scheme is only open to people from non-English speaking backgrounds that are 18 years old or over and are resident in NSW.
